

**RESOLUTION OF CARSON COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 1
ADOPTING A TAX RATE FOR THE YEAR 2025**

WHEREAS, the Board of Commissioners of Carson County Emergency Services District No. 1 (“District”) is authorized by law to levy and collect ad valorem taxes for the support of emergency services within the District; and

WHEREAS, the Board has duly considered the District’s budgetary needs and financial obligations for the fiscal year beginning October 1, 2025 and ending September 30, 2026; and

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that adoption of the following tax rate is necessary to provide adequate funding for the District’s operations and services;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS OF CARSON COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 1 THAT:

1. The ad valorem tax rate for the District for the year 2025, to fund maintenance and operations of the District, is hereby set at \$0.10 per \$100 of taxable property valuation within the District as determined by the Carson County Appraisal District.
2. The tax rate consists of a Maintenance & Operations (M&O) rate of \$0.10 per \$100 valuation and an Interest & Sinking I&S rate of \$0.00 per \$100 valuation, for a total tax rate of \$0.10 per \$100 valuation.
3. The President of the Board is hereby authorized to execute this Resolution, and the Secretary to attest this resolution on behalf of the Board of Commissioners.

PASSED, APPROVED, AND ADOPTED this 28th day of August, 2025, by a vote of 5 “Ayes” and 0 “Nays.”
